

## vPUK Poster Presenting Guidance

This guidance provides you with information on how to present your poster at vPUK.

### Location

Each poster will be displayed in its own booth, please see picture below:



Poster Booth

The booths have been coloured coded to a theme.

To locate your poster booth please use the area code (hall, row, booth) you have been given, head to the poster hall you are in and then follow the row signage above and floor numbers to find your booth. See picture below:



Row number

Private volume area highlighted by the blue line

Floor number

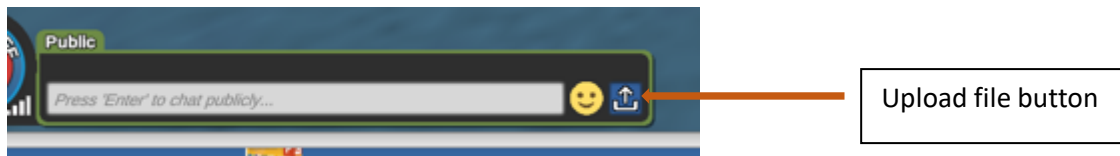
## Sound

Each booth has its own private volume area. A private volume area means that only people within this area can hear each other. The private volume area is marked by a blue line around it which you can see in the picture above and your speech bubble will turn blue, instead of white. Using this private volume area can be helpful when there are large numbers of people within the Poster Hall and you wish to have private conversations with individuals or groups of individuals.

## PDF handouts

If you would like to share a PDF copy of your poster or a document with another delegate you can do this via uploading a document to a private chat. To start a private chat please select the arrow next to the name of the person you wish to chat to from the blue left hand menu. You will see a list of options: select private chat.

In the private chat please use the upload button to upload the file you wish to share.
